WSCGA Foundation Grant Application

Purpose

The WSCGA Foundation created the Regional Grants in 2002 to help support girls' participation in golf by awarding grants to individuals and/or organizations, programs and projects that introduce, nurture, sustain and support girls' participation and interest in the game of golf.

Eligibility

Grants for Individuals

Individuals can receive grants to help pay for golf-related expenses. Examples of this are travel and tournament entry fees or golf camp/special instruction fees. Due to eligibility requirements and amateur status, some grants may be awarded in the form of a reimbursement.

Grants for Organizations, Programs and Projects

Organizations, programs and projects that introduce, nurture, sustain and support girls' participation and interest in the game of golf are eligible to receive grants from the WSCGA Foundation. The Foundation is especially interested in funding initiatives that stress character development and teach life-enhancing values, increase accessibility of the game to girls and women, and increase the opportunity for female involvement, as both players and business professionals, in the golf industry.

The WSCGA Foundation also awards grants to high school girls' golf programs to help with equipment expenses, tournament expenses and other program related needs. Funds can be used for the following purposes: equipment, uniforms, green fees, driving range cards, instruction, facility rental and travel expense for play in amateur competitions.

Awards

- Grant awards will be based on demonstrated need.
- Only one award per individual, organization, program or project per year.

Application Procedure

- Applications are available online at www.wscgafoundation.org in a downloadable PDF format or can be filled out and submitted online.
- Complete application and submit to the WSCGA Foundation on or before the May 15 due date. Please submit a photograph of the applicant or program participants with the application.
- Hard copy applications should be typed.

Notification

- Notice of grant awards will be provided to all grant applicants by mail.

Judging Criteria

- Demonstrate commitment to girls'/women's golf.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Thoroughly explain the use of funds and how it relates to the mission of the WSCGA Foundation.
- Illustrate impact: Indicate the number of girls served, how greater female access will be achieved, participation opportunities, development of golf skill and the nature of the program.
